HOW TO APPLY



*TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- 24 transferable hours from a regionally-accredited institution
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative college GPA for all courses, as calculated by Undergraduate Admissions
- · Eligible to return to last institution attended
- · Demonstrated math proficiency at college or high school level

*Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission. Applicants with less than 24 transferable credit hours should contact a Transfer Admissions Counselor to discuss admissions criteria using high school performance. Transfer admission requirements are subject to change without notice. Refer to our website for the most up-to-date information.
