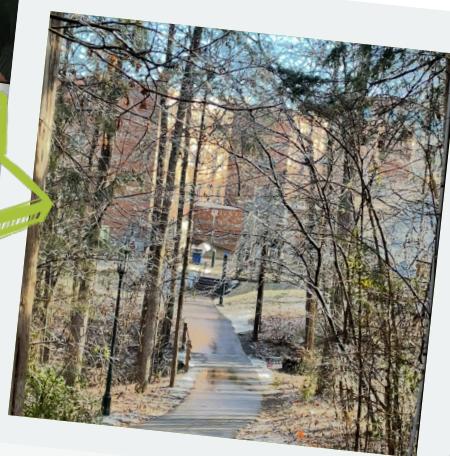

MAJORS WITH ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Due to their competitive nature, admission into some degree programs requires a higher GPA, additional coursework and/or certain grades prior to transferring.

HOW TO APPLY



*TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- 24 transferable hours from a regionally-accredited institution
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative college GPA for all courses, as calculated by Undergraduate Admissions
- Eligible to return to last institution attended
- Demonstrated math proficiency at college or high school level

**Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission. Applicants with less than 24 transferable credit hours should contact a Transfer Admissions Counselor to discuss admissions criteria using high school performance. Transfer admission requirements are subject to change without notice. Refer to our website for the most up-to-date information.*

1. COMPLETE AN APPLICATION

Complete an online application in your Future 49er Portal.

2. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION FEE

Pay the \$75 application fee in your Future 49er Portal.

3. SEND YOUR OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS*

Request and send transcripts from each of the colleges you have previously attended. Monitor the status of your application and supporting documents in your Future 49er Portal.

Submit Online	Use your previous institution's secured electronic system. Select UNC Charlotte Undergraduate Admissions or admissions@charlotte.edu .
Submit by Mail	Have your previous institution mail your transcript to: UNC Charlotte Undergraduate Admissions 9201 University City Blvd / Charlotte, NC 28223
Submit In-Person	Deliver your transcript in a sealed envelope to our team in the Gage Undergraduate Admissions Center.

**List all courses in progress on your online application. At the end of your current term, make sure to send your official college transcript(s) to Undergraduate Admissions following the instructions above.*

ESTIMATED COST OF ATTENDANCE

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

finaid.charlotte.edu

Financial aid offers primarily include grants, work study employment, student loans and parent loans. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov so that Charlotte can determine your financial aid offer. Include our school code (002975) on your FAFSA to ensure Charlotte receives your application.

APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

After being admitted, set up your NinerScholars Portal to be matched with eligible scholarships. Review the scholarships available to you and submit your applications directly through the portal. Most scholarship deadlines are in early Spring, so apply as early as you can!
