ACADEMIC PROGRAM UPDATES

- **Engineering Technology** has added a new transfer admission requirement. To be competitive for admission a student will need Precalculus (MAT 172) and at least a 2.5 GPA or higher. (Excluding Construction Management and Fire & Safety Engineering Technology).
- **Three new degree programs** launching Fall 2026 - a Bachelor of Science in Artificial Intelligence, a Bachelor of Science in Construction Engineering, and a Master of Science in Artificial Intelligence.
