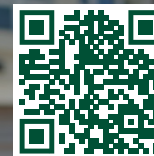

Jackson Mullins doesn't
just watch from the sidelines.

HE HELPS COACH THE GAME.

As lead analyst for NinerStats, Mullins works directly with UNC Charlotte's men's basketball coaching staff – tracking possession times, ball reversals and the metrics that tell a coaching staff what an opposing team is about to do before they do it.

"The opportunity to work with a coaching staff and other students to provide real-game data to a major collegiate sports team has been not only eye-opening but great practice for after I graduate."

Mullins is enrolled in UNC Charlotte's Sports Analytics program – the only bachelor's degree of its kind in the Southeast and one of five in the nation. The program combines data science, machine learning and the anatomy and physiology of human performance. From day one, it puts students inside real locker rooms working with real teams.

Taliyah Green sees something most people miss when they look at finance:

A WAY TO CHANGE HER COMMUNITY.

The Niblock Scholar and Belk College of Business junior is already doing it. She serves as chapter president of First Generation Investors, a nonprofit that sends college students into high school classrooms to teach financial literacy. She coaches fellow students through Niner Finances, helping them file taxes and build lifelong financial roadmaps. And she's currently interning at JP Morgan – with plans to turn it into a full-time offer after graduation.

"My parents taught me to be able to speak, not only for myself, but also for those whose voices remain unheard," Green said. "Selfless service is something I'm always here for."

Her path from Atlanta to Charlotte included a scholarship that recognized exactly who she was: someone who showed up ready to lead. She's been doing it ever since – at the Dean's council, in front of C-suite executives and, before that, at the U.S. Department of Justice.

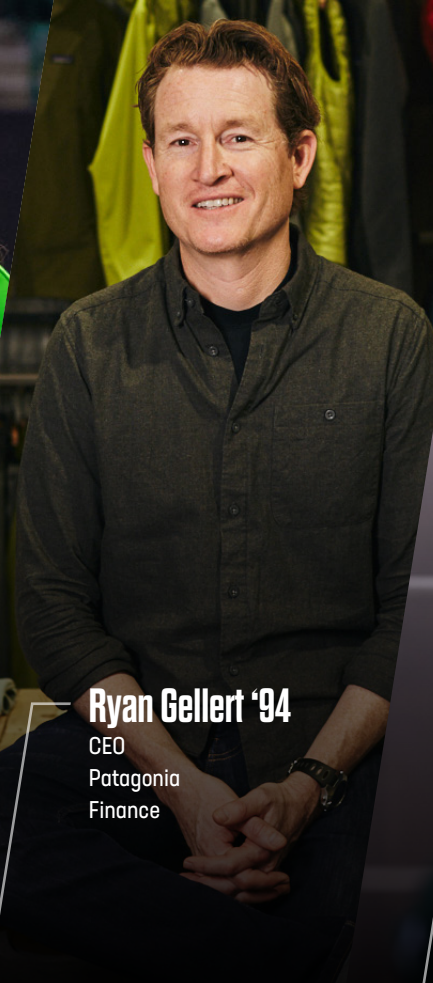
