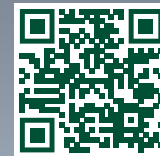

PREPARING TO TRANSFER

HOW TO APPLY

1. COMPLETE AN APPLICATION

Complete an online application in your Future 49er Portal.

2. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION FEE

Pay the \$75 application fee in your Future 49er Portal.

3. SEND YOUR OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Request transcripts from each college you have attended via the methods below. Send an updated transcript at the end of your current term.

ONLINE	Use your previous institution's secured electronic system. Select <i>UNC Charlotte Undergraduate Admissions</i> or admissions@charlotte.edu
BY MAIL	Have your previous institution mail your transcript: UNC Charlotte Undergraduate Admissions 9201 University City Blvd / Charlotte, NC 28223
IN-PERSON	Deliver your transcript in a sealed envelope to our team in the Gage Undergraduate Admissions Center

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- 24 transferable credit hours from a regionally-accredited institution
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative college GPA for all courses, as calculated by Undergraduate Admissions
- Eligible to return to last institution attended
- Demonstrated math proficiency at the college or high school level

**Meeting requirements does not guarantee admission. Applicants with less than 24 transferable credit hours may be evaluated on their high school performance. Transfer admissions requirements are subject to change without notice. Refer to our website for the most up-to-date information.*

N.C. RESIDENTS: APPLY FOR RESIDENCY



The Residency Determination Service (RDS) is the centralized system in North Carolina for determining residency for students. North Carolina substantially subsidizes the cost of tuition for all students whose permanent legal residence is in the state.
