Additional Requirements for Admission to the upper division in Architecture		Only architecture coursework completed at a NAAB-accredited institution can be evaluated for transfer. This Completion Agreement leads to a Bachelor of Arts in Architecture (non-pre-professional) degree that includes a minimum of three years of design studio, rather than the typical four years of studio for the Bachelor of Arts in Architecture (pre-professional). Completing the B Arts in Architecture degree with three years of design studio qualifies students to apply for Master of Architecture programs; four years of studio are required to apply for the Bachelor of Architecture (5th Year) degree program.
