FAQs

CAN MY SPRING ADMISSION BE RECONSIDERED FOR FALL 2023?

In the event that space becomes available for the fall, we will look to the students who have confirmed their intent to enroll for spring to offer an earlier enrollment option. Space availability varies year to year. If we are able to offer you fall admission, we will contact you after May 1.

IF MY ADMISSION DECISION ISN'T RECONSIDERED, THEN WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS FOR FALL?

Students are highly advised to take classes at another institution for Fall 2023 and expected to earn a "C" or higher. We recommend that you enroll in 12 to 15 credit hours. If you intend to take classes this fall, reach out to one of our admissions counselors for any assistance you may need. Outside of fall coursework, additional options could be community service or employment.

YOUR TIMELINE FOR STARTING IN SPRING



TODAY / CONNECT & VISIT

- Be on the lookout for an invitation to spring admission information sessions! These events will cover next steps and much more.
- Check out our campus by doing a self-guided tour and meeting with an admissions counselor in-person. No appointment necessary.

JUNE / DECIDE

- If you have decided to enroll at Charlotte for Spring 2024, submit your Intent to Enroll in the Future 49er Portal by June 1.

JULY / SEND DOCUMENTS

- Request that your high school send Undergraduate Admissions your final high school transcript (stating your high school graduation date).
- Also, send us your official SAT and/or ACT test score report if you haven't already done so. Your Future 49er Portal will show if this is a requirement for you.

AUGUST / TAKE CLASSES

- We encourage you to enroll in transferable courses at another college this fall.
- To review course recommendations and how classes transfer, view our transfer credit tools at admissions.charlotte.edu/transfers/how-credits-transfer or speak with an admissions counselor.

SEPTEMBER / FAFSA

- Submit the 2023-2024 FAFSA or add our school code (**002975**) to your existing FAFSA to be eligible for spring financial aid at UNC Charlotte. The 2023-2024 FAFSA is for Fall 2023/Spring 2024/Summer 2024 aid.

OCTOBER / PREPARE

- Sign up for a New Student Orientation session, where you will meet with an academic advisor and register for classes. Reservations for orientation open in mid-fall. Additional details to be announced.
- Apply for on-campus housing as the spring application opens this month.

NOVEMBER / VIEW AID OFFER

- If you have added the UNC Charlotte school code to your FAFSA and completed all your requirements, you will receive an aid package in November.

DECEMBER / FINISH STRONG

- If you took fall classes, send your final college transcript to Charlotte.

JANUARY / WELCOME!

- New Student Orientation is held in early January, prior to the start of classes.
- More information on advising and registration will be sent via email in Fall 2023.
- The first day of classes is January 10, 2024.
