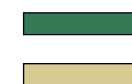

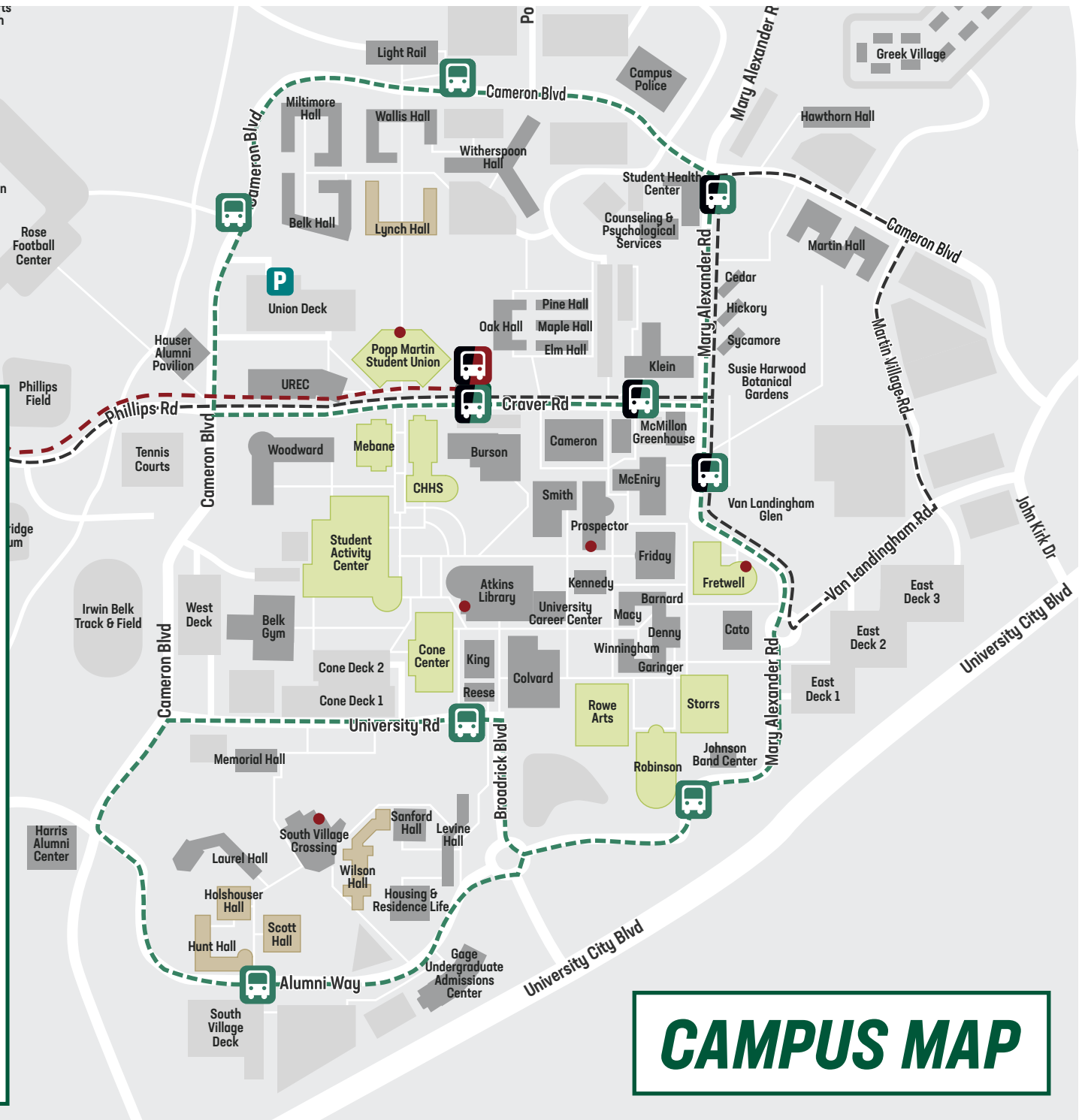
**Green Route:** Central, North and South campus

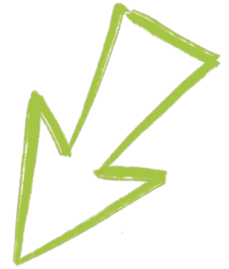
